





A COMMUNITY UNITED IN TRIBUTE

If you've driven through Lower Township lately and have seen the banners hanging along Bayshore, Seashore, and Breakwater Roads, you've witnessed something special. They are a visible reminder of the courage, service, and sacrifice that define this community. These banners are part of the Hometown Hero Project, a collaborative effort to honor the veterans, first responders, and military families who have dedicated their lives to protecting and serving others.

The project is the result of a true community partnership among Mayor Frank Sippel and the Township Council, the Lower Township Chamber of Commerce, and the Citizens/Veterans Advisory Committee (CVAC). The project took shape when the Township Council formally supported the Chamber's Hometown Heroes Campaign in June 2025, signaling the beginning of a program de-

signed to make gratitude visible across the township.

The very first flag was raised on October 6, 2025, in honor and remembrance of Officer David C. Douglass, who served on the Lower Township Police Department for 18 years before losing his life in the line of duty on February 18, 1994. In addition to his police service, Douglass was a Lieutenant in the Town Bank Fire Department, a founding member of the Township's SWAT team, and an instructor at the Cape May County Police Academy. His life of service represents exactly what these flags stand for.

From that first flag on Veterans Way, the project has grown into a township-wide display of pride and remembrance. What began with a handful of business-sponsored flags has expanded to 66 Hometown Hero and business banners. Each one represents


a story of courage, love of community, and the ties that bind Lower Township together.

The Lower Township Chamber of Commerce sponsored the Douglass flag and continues to support this effort alongside CVAC and the Township's Public Works Department. Together, they hope to see even more flags added in the years to come, with a goal of reaching 100 banners flying high across the township.

Each flag tells a story. Each name represents a life of service. And each display reminds us that heroism isn't something found in faraway places, it's right here at home.

THE EASTER EGG HUNT/ SPRING FLING is a Spring-time activity for children up to and including the fourth grade. Children are divided into age groups and each "Hunt" in their own area. THE COOMBS/DOUGLASS MEMORIAL BAY RUN is held on the first Saturday in August of each year. This event consists of a five mile certified run and a two mile health run/walk. Prizes in designated age categories and a pancake breakfast at the end. **Tentative date for this event is scheduled for August 1, 2026.**

FAMILY FUN NIGHT/MOVIES IN THE PARK - this program features live music, food trucks, vendors, mobile zoo, lawn games, movies and much more. This fun and family-friendly event is perfect for everyone. **Tentative Date for this event is September 18, 2026.**

THE HALLOWEEN COSTUME PARADE is an October event that is part of The Rotary Club's Annual Pumpkin Festival. Line up for the parade and costume judging. Prizes will be awarded in a variety of age groups from infants to groups/families. Prizes are awarded at the conclusion of the parade. **Tentative date for this event is scheduled for October 10, 2026.**

THE ANNUAL TRUNK OR TREAT event is a fun, safe, interactive Halloween event! People gather in a large area, go all out decorating the trunks of their car, and kids are able to trick or treat by going from trunk! **Tentative date for this event is scheduled for October 18, 2026.**

HAUNTED TRAILS in Lower Township is back! This fun and family-friendly event is perfect for everyone. There will be plenty of screams and nervous laughs compliments of the scary Halloween characters. **Tentative date for this event is scheduled for October 24, 2026.**

LOWER TOWNSHIP'S ANNUAL VETERANS DAY PARADE honors those who have served in the United States Military. Parade attendees can expect some of the same favorites as years past, such as a line-up of military and first responder vehicles, music from our local high school marching band, and representatives from the United States Coast Guard. **Tentative date for this event is scheduled for November 7, 2026.**

THE FERRY MERRY CHRISTMAS event is held in December each year. The Delaware River and Bay Authority Ferry Terminal is the location of this event. There will be games for kids, along with face painting, arts and crafts, and Santa will make a visit. **Tentative date for this event is scheduled for December 13, 2026.**

THE ANNUAL TOM BEHELER/GREATER CAPE MAY ELKS YOUTH BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT is a grade school basketball tournament that traditionally consists of teams from Cape May, Cumberland, and Atlantic Counties. Age groups consist of teams ranging from 3rd grade to 8th grade. Tom Beheler was a former Lower Township Resident and local businessman who was instrumental in helping thousands of youth in the Township during his entrepreneurial days in our Community. **Tentative date for this event is scheduled for December 27,28,29, 2026.**



CODE ENFORCEMENT

All homeowners are required to keep their properties in a clean, safe & sanitary condition. Grass should be kept cut under 10 inches and trash and debris should not accumulate on property. Call 886-2624 for general information on property maintenance and other code requirements.

DOGS

Section 5-1 "No person shall keep, harbor or maintain a dog which habitually cries, barks, howls or otherwise disturbs the peace. No person owning, possessing or harboring a dog shall suffer or permit it to be in the public highways or any place in township other than on the premises of the processor, unless such dog is accompanied by a person over the age of 12 and is securely confined and controlled by an adequate leash not more than six feet in length.

Section 5-2 "All dogs over the age of six months shall be

required to be licensed and a license for same shall be obtained and attached to the harness or collar of each dog prior to January 31 of each year..." For licensing information call the Clerk's Office at 886-2005.

Lower Township has a "Pooper Scooper" law in effect. All dogs must be curbed and all feces removed in a sanitary method.

Anyone who fails to comply with any of the above provisions is subject to a local ordinance summons.

Vicious/Potentially Dangerous Dogs

Any person owning a dog declared by the Municipal Court to be vicious or potentially dangerous will be subject to all requirements of Ord. #2003-6 including a

\$700 license fee.







For Dennis Lennon, a proud Lower Township resident and former officer of the Greater Cape May Elks, it's never too late to finish what you started.

By chance, during a casual conversation, Denny learned that one of his fellow Elks members is a teacher at Northeast High School in Philadelphia. Surprised by the coincidence, Denny shared with the teacher that he had once attended Northeast himself but left before graduating—a decision that became one of his biggest regrets. Denny left Northeast in 1966 to serve his country during the Vietnam era. Enlisting in the U.S. Army, he spent two years on active duty and four years in the reserves. Stationed in Germany, Denny used his automotive repair skills to support the mission overseas while carrying the memory of his close friend Francis Ludwig, who was killed in action in 1967.

That casual, chance conversation set something remarkable in motion. With the help of this fellow Elk and many staff members at Northeast High, Denny was invited back to his alma mater to finally take part in the school's graduation ceremony. In June 2025, 58 years after leaving school, he received his diploma in front of family and friends, closing a long and meaningful chapter of his life.

"It's amazing how it made me feel," Denny said. "A little hole in my life was filled."

Today, his diploma hangs proudly on the wall of his Lower Township home, a daily reminder that service, perseverance, and community can bring dreams full circle, no matter how many years have passed.
